STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

GENERAL INFORMATION: Monterey Weed-Hoe is a postemergence herbicide for use in turf. Monterey Weed-Hoe contains a surfactant (wetting agent) in proper ratio for best results. It is not necessary to add additional surfactant to the spray tank.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS: Fill the spray tank with half the required amount of water and add the recommended amount of Monterey Weed-Hoe and continue filling the tank with the balance of water and mix thoroughly. DO NOT store spray solution in tank overnight. Clean application equipment thoroughly after use by flushing with water in a safe place.

APPLICATION METHODS: Monterey Weed-Hoe should be applied with a low-pressure sprayer. Adequate coverage is important for effective weed control. Apply during warm weather and when weeds are in an active stage of growth. Application should be uniform and thorough to adequately wet all undesirable plants. DO NOT apply with hose-end applicators.

ORNAMENTAL TURFGRASS: Monterey Weed-Hoe can be used for selective control of the weeds listed above with little or no injury to well established, actively growing turfgrasses. Mow turfgrass to height of 1 to 1½ inches before treatment. Mix 1 fluid ounce (2 tablespoons) of Monterey Weed-Hoe in 1 to 2½ gallons of water for application to an area of 1,000 square feet. **Established Bermudagrass and Zoysiagrass:** Mix 1 to 2 fluid ounces (2 to 4 tablespoons) of Monterey Weed-Hoe in 1 to 2½ gallons of water for application to an area of 1,000 square feet.

Application should be uniform and thorough to adequately wet all undesirable plants. Two or more repeat treatments at 14 day intervals may be necessary. Make applications during warm weather when temperature is between 80 and 90°F. DO NOT water turf for at least 24 hours after application. Turfgrasses may be temporarily discolored. Bermudagrass, bluegrasses and zoysiagrass have shown tolerance to properly applied Monterey Weed-Hoe. Injury may result if applied to bentgrasses and fescues. DO NOT apply to carpetgrass, centipedegrass, Dichondra or St. Augustinegrass. DO NOT reseed until two weeks after last application.
